Cookies Policy

Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third-parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, and your choices regarding cookies.

What are Cookies

A cookie is a small file of text, stored on your computer that file contains a limited amount of data sent by your web browser by a website you visit, or on certain emails you open. Cookies can be read by the web server or the client computer. It allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you, as an unique user of a Website and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you.

Cookies are widely used and accepted as an integral part of a fully functioning internet. Many websites use cookies for their core processes, so rejecting those blocks much or all site functionality. Cookies enable smoother, more efficient site use by visitors by storing your site-specific information and preferences such as theme, language setting, privacy preferences, and others. So wherever you go on the online world you will find cookies, being used by different reasons. Some are automatically enabled, as default to accept all cookies, by most of the web browsers, ad networks, or website platforms. These cookies can be from the site, or from third parties. Some are used on purpose, like on e-commerce sites, cookies also store your shopping cart contents and quick checkout options. Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies. Session Cookies are also used by the server to store information about user page activities. Persistent or tracking Cookies are also employed to store user preferences, making it easier to navigate.

We understand the complications of internet privacy and its relationship to cookies. We are for minimizing any personal intrusion and our cookie policy follows that strategy, and that we only place cookies that we find absolutely necessary. On our end, we ("the Service) try to treat your privacy as it was our own, and we don't retain any information that is personally identifiable, we as any internet "Service" or user/visitor, are dependant and bound to the technical functioning of the platforms we use and their collaboration to make our website possible. In that sense, we ("the Service") and the users, as public in general, all rely on the good faith of the platforms we use, and their own responsible and correct use of cookies and ethical ways of dealing and processing information.

Cookies on a mobile device

On mobile, phones or tablets, cookies try to do the same things they do on your desktop or laptop computer. However, on your computer cookies inhabit your browser(s), in mobile they also need to operate in your various native applications (more commonly known as apps). And this sets up a challenge for cookies because of the different type of devices, running different operating systems, with different mobile web browsers, each with its own rules, those browsers play in different "sandboxes" from the native apps on the same device. You can use an antivirus, but, tracking your online behaviour across all those mobile devices, networks, and apps it's a challenge. You should still be cautious with the WIFI, browser, etc.

Cookie details

There are different types of cookies, like: Session cookies, Google Analytics Cookies, Affiliate Cookies, Marketing Cookies and Third Party Cookies. In the past, and possibly in the future, we might use some or all of these. We use third-party cookies, to report usage statistics of the Service, deliver advertisements on and through the Service, and so on.

Session Cookies, allows knowing if a visitor is using the site as a guest, so users can easily pick up where they left off on the server's pages. By default, web pages really don't have any 'memory' so cookies act like a bookmark. Cookies also secure forms and site against malicious intent of hackers and spammers. The website, as a system, would be unusable without it.

Google Analytics Cookies are used to understand how our visitors navigate the website and interact with pages. All information collected is anonymous, and summarized to understand trends and site metrics. No information is used for marketing, tracking individual users, or revealing personal information.

Affiliate Cookies, in case of having an affiliate program in place, to understand when users are referred to this website from our partners. Cookies are placed to keep track of visitors for a limited amount of time.

We place Marketing Cookies when advertising with third party websites to keep track of costs of advertising.

Third party cookies, they are set by someone other for their own purposes, like when participate in online advertising campaigns, YouTube videos shown on the website, etc.
